Pumpkin Hill Creek Preserve State Park



“This newer Florida state park offers an evolving trail system through a variety of plant communities. This hike traces double-track paths through rare oak, scrub, pine flatwoods, maritime hammock, and along tidal Pumpkin Hill Creek with its extensive marshes.”

NOTES:

March 2017 – Great trail and great scenery. We definitely saw cat prints - maybe bobcat - and wild hogs on our hike! (Aubrey G.)

June 2018 – The trail which goes east to the waterway has a nice picnic table at the end – great place to relax, picnic, put in a kayak, and is very scenic. This is an under-utilized park, so you can often expect quite a bit of solitude while hiking here. (Derek N.)
