Robert W. Loftin Nature Trails: Dedicated August 31, 1993
Robert Loftin, along with the Sawmill Slough Conservation Club, UNF faculty, staff and community members established the nature trail system on campus. In early 1973 they were opened to the public and by 1978 were recognized as National Recreation Trails and listed as such by the US Department of the Interior.

All trailheads are adjacent to parking lot 100 and the Eco- Adventure Outfitters Center.
